



# Undergraduate Student Research Awards

Funding is available for undergraduate student research at Sacramento State through the CSU Council on Ocean Affairs, Science and Technology (COAST).



COAST promotes research & education to advance our knowledge of our natural marine and coastal resources and the processes that affect them. The scope of COAST includes the open and coastal ocean, coastal zones (bays, estuaries, beaches), and coastal watersheds to the extent that they ultimately articulate with the coast (e.g. anadromous fish, surface and groundwater flow, water quality, land use, etc.).

- Eligibility: Undergraduate student at CSUS, must have a faculty adviser, any major
- Research must be aligned with one or more of COAST's goals, See <http://www.calstate.edu/coast> for details
- Prepare a 500 word project description & 200 word personal statement with a faculty adviser (see application for details)
- Up to \$500 of funding for supplies, stipend, & other expenses
- Funds are for use in 2020-21 but can include summer research
- Application deadline: Friday, Oct 30, 2020 at 5:00pm
